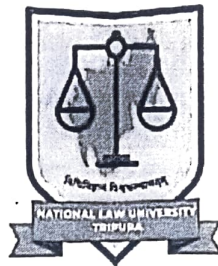

Objective

The Purpose of this MoU is to establish a Framework for cooperation and Collaboration between National Forensic Science University (NFSU), Tripura Campus and National Law University Tripura (NLU Tripura) in the fields of law, justice, and forensic sciences. This MoU aims to facilitate academic exchanges, research Collaboration, and the sharing of resources and expertise to strengthen the academic and professional development of both institutions.

SCOPE OF COLLABORATION

1. Academic Exchange programs

- Exchange of students for internships, research projects, and academic programs.
- Exchange of faculty for guest lectures, seminars, workshops and conferences.

2. Joint Research and publications

- Collaborative Research projects in the fields of law, justice and forensic science.
- Co- authorships of research paper and publications in national and international journals.

3. Curriculum Development

- Joint Development and Revision of curriculum to incorporate the latest advancement in law and forensic science.
- Designing and offering new courses and programs that leverage the strengths of both institutions.

4. Training and Capacity Building

- Organization of joint training programs, workshop, and seminars for students, faculty, and professionals.
- Development of online courses, and e- learning modules to enhance knowledge and skills in relevant areas.
- Joint Certificate & Diploma Courses.

5.Resource Sharing

- Sharing of library resources, database, and research materials.
- Access to laboratories, equipment and other facilities for academic and research purposes.

6.Student Support and Development

- Joint initiatives for career counseling, placement assistance, and internships.
- Collaboration in extracurricular activities, moot court competitions, and other student -centric events.

7. Expert Lectures and Seminars

- o Inviting experts from each institution to deliver lectures and conduct seminars on specialized topics.
- o Facilitating interactive sessions and professional development.

8. Legal Aid and Community Outreach

- o Joint initiatives to provide legal aid and forensic consultancy services to the community.
- o Collaborative outreach programs to educate the public on legal and forensic matters

9. a) A specific plan will be worked out for each activity; setting forth detailed arrangements for collaboration will be agreed. Terms and conditions for each visit or an assignment or such exchange, including those concerning financial implications will be worked out between the institutes. A separate agreement will be entered into giving such details including term of exchange of any intellectual property. This general agreement of cooperation shall be identified as the **parent document** of any program agreement executed between the parties. Further agreements concerning any program shall provide details concerning the **specific commitments** made by each party and shall not become effective until they have been reduced to writing and executed by the duly authorized representatives of the parties.

b) Except as may be stipulated in any specific program agreement, each be responsible for expenses incurred by its employees under this agreement. Before planning any joint activity, financial responsibilities of each party shall be reduced in writing and agreed upon.

c) This MoU may be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of both institutes.

d) Legal Effect: Nothing in this Memorandum shall be construed as creating any legal relationship between the institutes. This Memorandum is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration.
