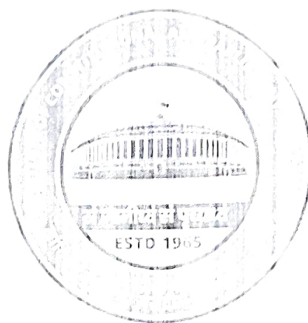

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)**  
**BETWEEN ICPS AND NLUT**

The Institute of Constitutional and Parliamentary Studies (hereinafter referred to as ICPS) and the National Law University, Tripura (hereinafter referred to as NLUT) desire to promote academic and training interaction/ cooperation between the two institutes. The memorandum of understanding (MoU), made on \_\_ day of June, 2025 between ICPS and NLUT witnessed as follows:

**1. Scope**

The main purpose of this MOU is to promote institutional association between ICPS and NLUT and to explore avenues for possible collaboration in the areas of parliamentary procedures, constitutional law, and legislative drafting and jointly conduct academic, research and training activities in the above areas depending upon the expertise available in the two organizations.

**2. Research Projects**

Faculty/ specialists/ experts/ researchers from ICPS and NLUT may jointly undertake research projects on themes related to Constitutional and Parliamentary studies as per following terms:

- Project proposals will be formulated jointly by the faculty/ specialists/ experts/ researchers designated for the purpose by the two organizations.
- Projects will require approval of both the organizations.
- The income, if any, arising out of such work will be shared by both the organizations on the basis of mutually agreed terms.

**3. Research Activities**

Both the organizations agree to jointly conduct/ organize research activities (seminars/ conferences/ workshops/ colloquia/ lectures, etc.) on issues and challenges in the field of Constitutional and Parliamentary studies from time to time on mutually agreed terms.

**4. Dissemination of Information/ Knowledge**

Both the organizations agree to jointly conduct/ organize, whenever feasible, courses/ programmes, etc. to disseminate knowledge about the Constitution of India, Institutions and Procedures of parliamentary democracy in India with a view to serve the cause of democracy in India.

**5. Training Courses**

ICPS and NLUT agree to organize training courses on Legislative Drafting, Parliamentary Procedures, etc.



## 6. Sharing of Expenditure

The expenditure in conducting various activities in furtherance of the MoU will be shared between the parties on mutually agreed terms.

## 7. Sharing of Faculty

ICPS and NLUT agree to share faculty/ specialists/ experts/ researchers for a limited period up to one year at a time for the purpose of implementation of joint tasks.

## 8. Sharing of Important Facility

The two organizations agree to share their important R&D facilities.


## 9. Intellectual Property Rights

The intellectual property rights that arise as a result of joint research and collaborative activity under the agreement will be worked out on a case-to-case basis and will be consistent with officially laid down IPR policies of the two organizations.

The Parties will, in particular, explore opportunities to build a cooperative working relationship in identified areas of common interest and share their resources mutually to:

- a) Conduct training programmes on Legislative Drafting, Parliamentary Procedures, etc.
- b) Conduct research on themes related to Constitutional and Parliamentary studies.
- c) Conduct courses/ programmes, etc. to disseminate knowledge about the Constitution of India, Institutions and Procedures of parliamentary democracy in India.
- d) Organise research activities (seminars/ conferences/ workshops/ colloquia/ lectures, etc.) on issues and challenges in the field of Constitutional and Parliamentary studies.
- e) Engage students by providing internship opportunities.

The specific activities to be undertaken under this MOU will be decided from time to time on mutual consultation or separate written arrangements depending on the requirements of the activities.

The collaboration would be without any financial commitment, other than specified in the MoU, though parties may separately consider the provisioning of need-based assistance for specified activities on a case-to-case basis.
