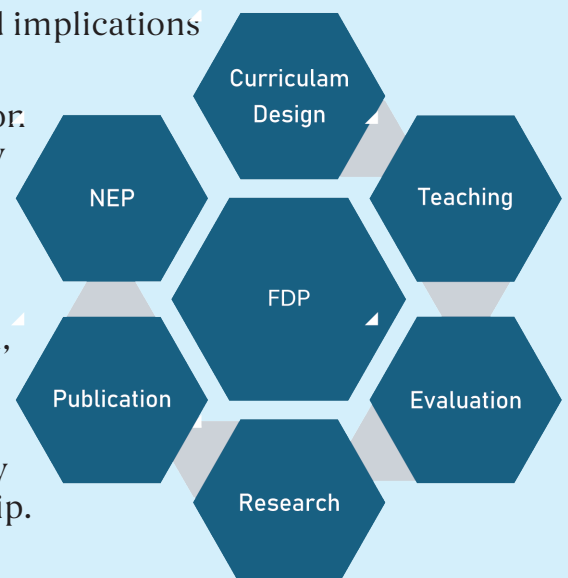
About NLU Tripura
